What is NCTF?

First, what it is not...the old Teaching Fellows Program!

- Legislatively mandated and funded program to promote teaching as a profession (NCGS § 116-209.62)
- Designed as a loan-forgiveness program that is application-based for students seeking admission into selected university programs (maximum of 8 at this time)
- Students may be awarded 4, 6, or 8 semesters of funding, maxed at \$4125 per semester

What is NCTF (continued)

- Students must be seeking admission to education preparation programs (EPPs) to study STEM or special education.
- It is open to high school seniors, current college students not in an EPP, transfer students from other colleges/universities (including community colleges), and current teachers seeking initial licensure in one of the above areas.
- Students must complete years of service as repayment of the loan in a public school after graduation.
- New teacher support for fellows



What is in the NCTF application

Students are scored on multiple measures

- GPA
- ACT/SAT (optional)
- Leadership/Service
- Awards/Recognitions
- Essays
- Interview
- Recommendations



Current NCTF Timeline

- October application opens
- January 27th application closes
- February 15 finalists identified
- February/March finalists interviewed by panel
- April 1 awards announce
- May 1 awardees must accept the award
