

What is the Basic Perkins Grant?

The Basic Perkins Grant is awarded to eligible institutions to support educating students enrolled in Career and Technical Education (CTE) curriculum Programs of Study that prepare them for high-skill, high-wage, and in-demand careers. Success is measure by an institution's ability to meet state-determined performance targets across three core indicators approved by the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Career, Technical, and Adult Education (OCTAE), as well as progress toward reducing performance gaps for students from special populations.

Who is Eligible to Apply/Receive Funds?

The Basic Perkins Grant is available for all public two-year institutions in North Carolina offering CTE Programs of Study leading to curriculum certificates, diplomas, or associate degrees. The grant is allocated on a noncompetitive basis to public career, state, and technical colleges designed to support the advancement of CTE Programs of Study for all students.
