

Batch Fast Path Analysis (FPAT) SOP

FPAT evaluates students' progress toward programs in which they are not active.

INFORMER

- Run "Active Students" to generate a list of active students and IDs (See Step 1 in the Identify Completers by Batch SOP)
- Export results to Excel CSV
- Filter out CCPP/CCPPE students and students with less than 12 credits.
- Break up list into groups of about 500

COLLEAGUE

- Create a Saved List (SLED) with groups of students – **STUJR (or your choice)**
- Create a Saved List (SLED) for programs of study (See CERT example below. Update program saved list at start of new academic year.)
 - Associate Degrees – **ASSOC**
 - Diploma Degrees – **DIPL**
 - Certificates – **CERT**

Catalog

- Run **FPAT**
- Run Student Saved List (**STUJR**) through all programs (**ASSOC, DIPL, CERT**)
- Save CSV with students who have completed degrees
- Run **PSPR** to evaluate student progress toward degree.
 - Check for credits earned at BCCC and GPA
- If student meets credit and GPA requirements, add program in **SACP** or use **BASP** to batch assign programs.
- Graduate students from completed degrees. Follow **Batch Graduation SOP**.
