**All Pathways are design to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS or BFA degree.**

Physical Therapists manage a wide variety of conditions. Physical Therapists examine patients and develop a plan of care that promotes movement, reduces pain, restores function, and prevents disability. The Physical Therapist works with the patient, family members, and other health care providers to ensure the goals of the plan of care are met and the patient outcomes are optimal.

In addition to earning a bachelor's degree, four more years earning a Doctorate in Physical Therapy (DPT) is required.
